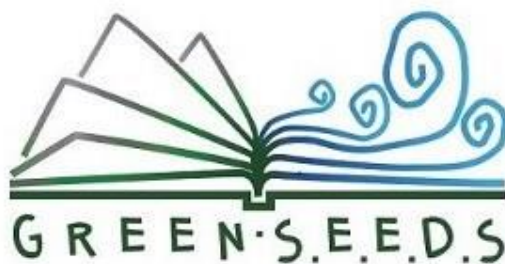

The first part - division into teams



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- *Through the Forms questionnaire conducted with first graders, we learned their interests and motivations, and we already know the successes from before. Based on this, we divided them into teams, creating heterogeneous groups to make the work on the tasks equal. We named the teams by colors: blue team, green team and yellow team. We were guided by the fact that each team has students from all three classes and that not all are the best students in terms of success in the same team. We made personalized ID cards for the teams to wear on their T-shirts. In addition, colored T-shirts and USBs were ordered, which we will share at the first team meetings.*

Part Two - Introduction to the Green Seeds Project



Jakica Pecotić, project leader, introduced the students to the project idea, goals, partners we work with and topics that will be addressed as part of the project. Topics that permeate the entire project relate to ecology and environmental protection.





Part Three - Activities and tasks that await students



In the third part, teacher Andrea presented to the students the tasks and activities that are expected of them. She explained to them the division into teams, the teachers who will work with them and what is expected of them. the topics they will cover are not the same for everyone. Each team works on one mandatory and one elective topic. An obligatory topic for everyone is Nature, biodiversity and ecosystem protection. Each group will receive a second or elective topic after today's task, which follows a little later. What is important and the point of it all is that each team must create, ie create one Seed Quest - project task on the obtained topic. In her presentation, Andrea encouraged the students to their creativity and all the qualities that will come to the fore in this team work.



Part Four - Treasure Hunt



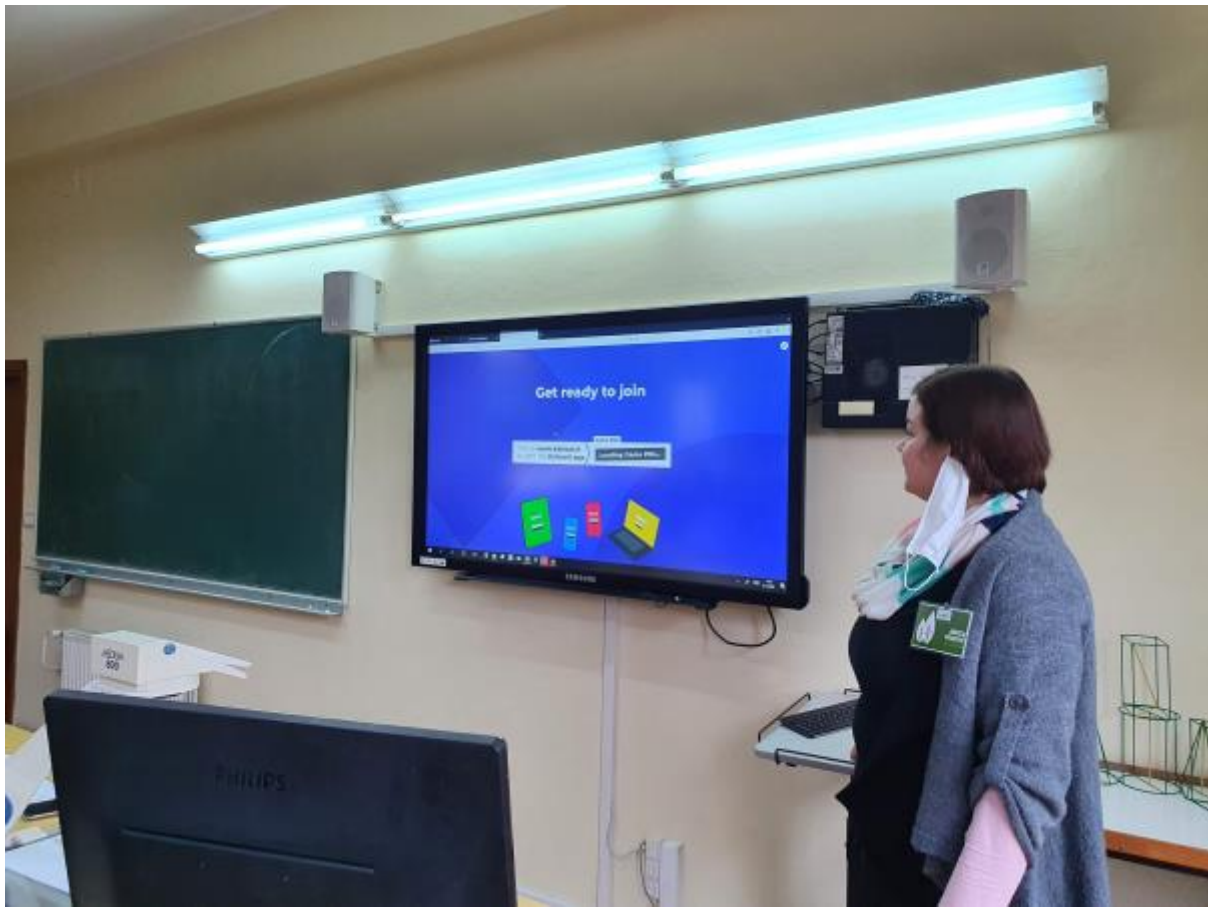
The selection of topics by teams is designed in such a way that the winners of the treasure hunt or "Escape Room" ie the most successful team has the advantage to choose between topics: 1. Forests as economic and social values, 2. Coast as socio-economic and cultural value and 3. Sea without plastic.

The search for the treasure was conceived by Darko and Sanda with the help of Miljenka, Marija and Andrea with pre-prepared tasks consisting of concepts related to our topics. The teams looked for notes with tasks, ie puzzles that were hidden all over the school. The search lasted almost an hour, and after that the fastest and most accurate was the blue team that had the opportunity to choose the topic of their choice. The second team is the yellow and the third the green team.

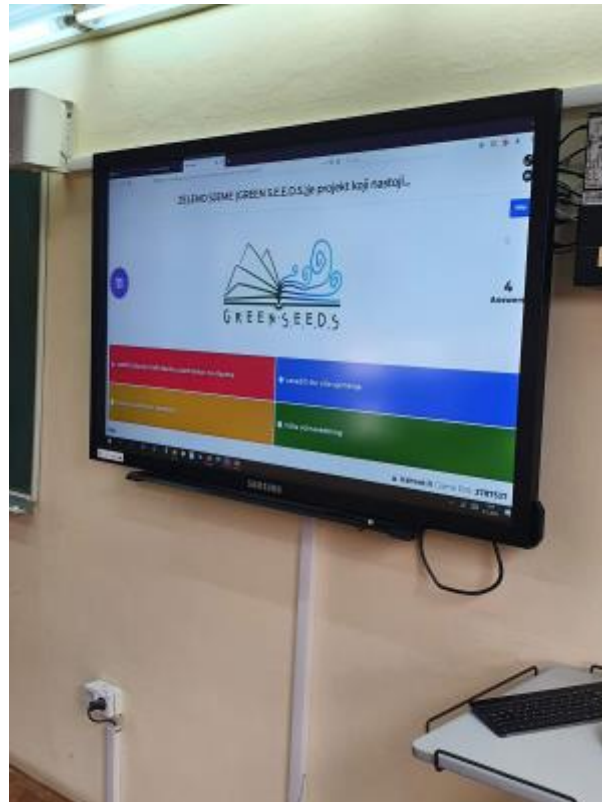


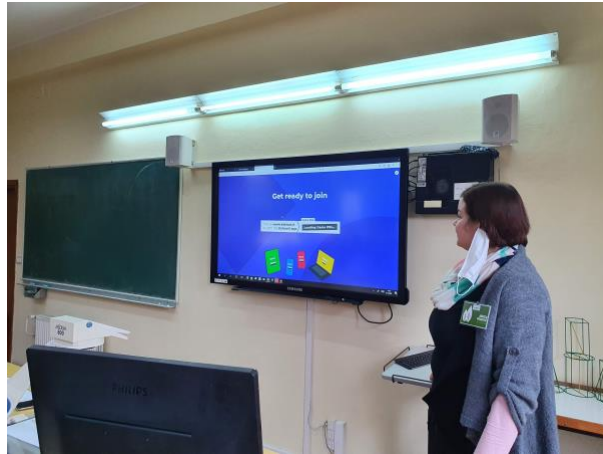


Part Five - Evaluate the Kahoot Quiz
